Now offering Rollovers for individuals with the DHTI+ Certification**

Also, current Basic RESI's who hold the DHTI+ certification may add the RESI AV endorsement for \$30.

With over 30 years of experience, ETA International is proud to provide the RESI professional certification for those who design and oversee the installation and integration of electronics systems in residences and light commercial buildings. The objective of the Integrator is to produce a residential or light commercial electronics systems package that will allow all data, control and communication signals to be integrated at the premise controller and converged into one secure cohesive communication stream, to either be used within the premise or to be passed back and forth through the gateway. The RESI should be proficient in the many protocols used over diverse media to communicate with and control residential and light commercial electronics systems.

The RESI program offers a Basic certification examination and five (5) endorsements in Audio/Video (AV), Computer Networking (CN), Security-Surveillance (SS), Closed-Circuit TV (CCTV), and Environmental Control (EC). Individuals may also achieve Master RESI status by having an extensive knowledge of the operation and technology and a proficiency in each of these areas. The Master RESI requires the candidate to pass comprehensive exams for the Basic RESI, all five endorsements, and a separate Master RESI exam.
