ETA Accepts FCC GROL License for Wireless Communications Rollover

Individuals who have recently earned the FCC GROL (Elements 1 and 3) license may rollover to the ETA Certified Electronics Technician Wireless Communications certification.

The rollover only applies to individuals who have tested with the new FCC questions pools that became effective December 26, 2009. ETA will not accept licenses earned prior to this date. A GROL together with an ETA Associate CET (CETa) qualifies for a rollover to ETA's Journeyman Wireless Communications (WCM) certification. The rollover fee is \$75.

ETA Certification Administrators have the ability to offer FCC examinations thru traditional paper testing or they may utilize ETA's online testing. ETA is one of the original COLEMS and has been administering FCC license examinations since 1993.

ETA also accepts several other rollovers, as follows:

- CompTIA A+ Rollover to CST - \$50
- CompTIA Network+ Rollover to CNST - \$75
- CompTIA DHTI+ to Basic RESI and AV Endorsement - \$50
- FCC Element 8 + Associate CET to RADAR - \$50
